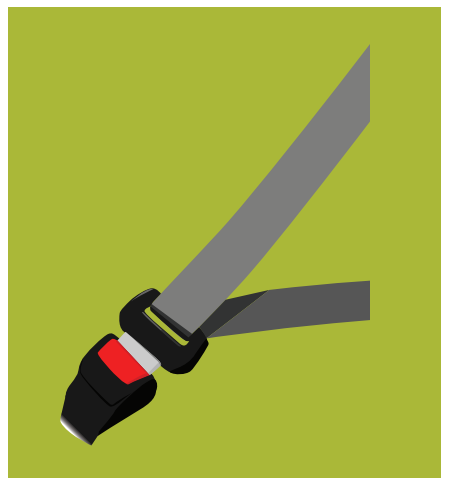
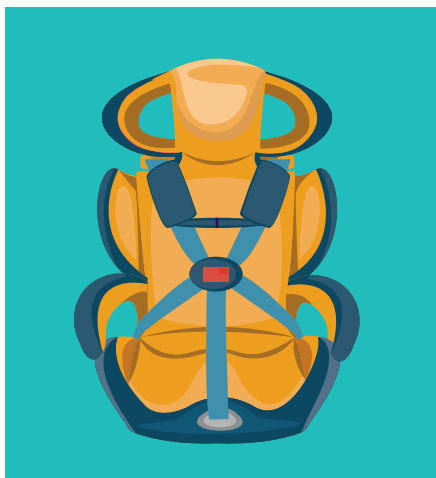
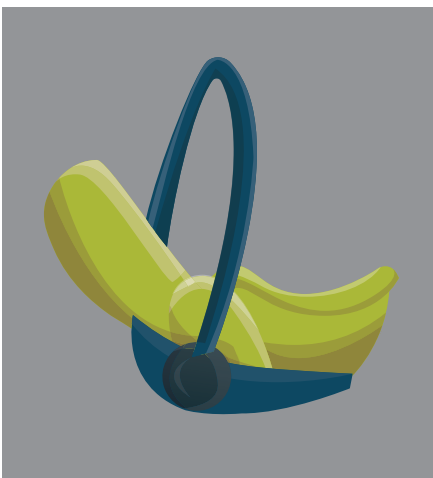

# AS YOUR CHILD DEVELOPS, SO SHOULD THEIR CAR SEAT.

## THE RIGHT SEAT IS THE SAFE SEAT



### Rear-Facing

As long as possible - often until after age 2 and 30 lbs.



### Forward-Facing

Use until the child reaches the highest weight or height allowed by the car seat manufacturer.



### Booster

Once a child is too big for a forward-facing seat, move to the booster. At least age 4 and 40 lbs.



### Seat Belt

Booster seat recommended until seat belt fits correctly. No younger than age eight.
